

Dress Code (Boys)

HAIR COLOR – Boys are to maintain a natural hair color. Multi-colored or non-natural colors (pink, purple, green, blue, etc.) are not allowed.

HAIR STYLE – Boys' hair must be off the collar and ears, and sideburns no longer than the middle of the ear. It should stay clear of the face and eyes.

FACE - No facial hair is allowed.

EARS – No jewelry is allowed.

NECK – No jewelry is allowed.

TORSO – Boys are allowed to wear a uniform blue, cobalt, orange spice, teal or gray polo (long or short sleeved) with SAINTS embroidery. These can be purchased (new) from Heartland Gear Provider [H & M Printing](#) or (used) from the Heartland FB page.

- The polo should not be form fitting.
- For added warmth, boys may wear an approved Saints hoodie or sweater. It is not allowable to wear a long-sleeved shirt under a short-sleeved polo.

HANDS - No rings or bracelets (bands) are allowed.

LOWER BODY - Boys may wear Khaki, Navy, or Charcoal Gray full-length pants. Cargo and Jogger pants are NOT allowed. Athletic pants may be worn on PE days only.

A BELT - Is required for grades 7-12. A belt is optional in grades K-6.

FEET - Any style of comfortable non-marking-sole shoe may be worn. Sandals, slides, flip-flops, crocs, and Heely's (any shoes with wheels) are NOT allowed.

PE UNIFORM (Boys & Girls)

Grades K-6 are not required to have a specific PE uniform. The daily uniform is sufficient.

A PE uniform shirt is available for purchase from the Uniform Page of our website (This is not a requirement but recommended for grades 7-12 only).

Boys in Grades 7-12 may wear athletic pants of any color/style, but they should be loose fitting.

Girls in Grades 7-12 may wear the athletic skort that is worn in the LC, OR a custom fit culotte purchased from HCS.

Tennis shoes are required at PE time.

Dress Code (Girls)

HAIR COLOR – Girls are to maintain a natural hair color. Multi-colored or non-natural colors (pink, purple, green, blue, etc.) are not allowed.

HAIR STYLE – Girls should keep their hair neat and back away from the face and eyes. Their hair should be allowed to grow long and be distinctly feminine.

FACE – Cosmetics (facial make-up, eye makeup) are to match the student's natural skin-tone ONLY for a *barely there* outcome.

EARS – No jewelry is allowed. Students may cover earrings with band aids if they cannot be removed. Clear plastic posts may also be worn instead of band aids.

NECK – No jewelry is allowed.

TORSO – Girls are allowed to wear a uniform blue, cobalt, orange spice, teal, or gray polo (long or short sleeved) with SAINTS embroidery. These can be purchased (new) from Heartland Gear Provider [H & M Printing](#) or used from the Heartland FB page.

- The polo should not be form fitting.
- For added warmth, girls may wear an approved Saints hoodie or sweater. It is not allowable to wear a long-sleeved shirt under a short-sleeved polo.

HANDS – No rings or bracelets (bands) are allowed.

FINGERNAILS – Nails should be at a moderate length at most. If nail polish is worn, it should be clear or your natural skin-tone.

WAIST-TO-2" BELOW THE KNEE

- Grades K-6 are allowed to wear a skirt or athletic skort
- Grades 7-12 are limited to an athletic skort. Here are Two Options to choose from if desired but not required as long as it fits within the color and length/skort guidelines:

COLOR: Navy, Khaki, Black and Charcoal Gray are the only 4 options. (These do NOT include other shades of blue, brown, or heathered gray etc.) No adornment or accent trim is acceptable.

FABRIC: Durable woven or knit fabrics are acceptable if it is NOT sheer. (Under normal lighting conditions the silhouette of legs should not be visible.)

FIT: The skirt/skort should have sufficient fullness that is suitable for physical activity. The garment must fall loosely below the derriere - not form fitting.

It needs to have a hem that falls two inches below the knee (sitting or standing).

STYLE: Skirt may NOT have a SLIT in any location or of any length. Skirt may NOT be wrap-style, nor a button-down style.

LEGS – Leggings (not pants) that closely match the skirt color may be worn in addition to skirt, but not INSTEAD of skirt.

FEET – Any style of comfortable non-marking-sole shoe may be worn. Sandals, slides, flip-flops, crocs, and Heely's (any shoes with wheels) are NOT allowed.
